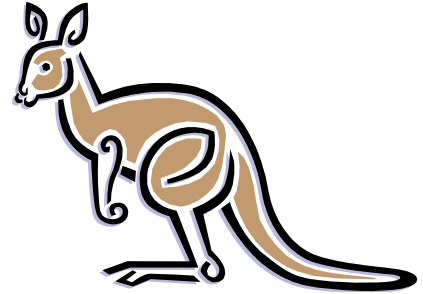

Mailing address and closing date are shown on the entry form. No late entries will be accepted.

All entrants must hold a current BMX Australia open license or a UCI International license to be eligible to ride in this event. International riders not holding a current UCI International license will be required to purchase a single day (\$A15) or a three day (\$A20) BMXA license to compete in these events.

It is the riders' responsibility:

- to check if an entry has been received. Entry lists will be progressively updated on - (<http://sabmxa.bmx.com.au>)
- to ensure they register, check moto sheets, attend staging on time and ride in their correct moto.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All Australian riders must be a financial member of an Australian affiliated BMX Club.
- Club licenses are not acceptable for this event.
- If insufficient entries are received to form a Class, classes will be merged.
- Age determination is 2009 minus year of birth.
- Sprocket classes, age on day, must be at least 5 years of age.
- Souvenir plate will be allocated at registration and must be used at both events.
- No refunds after the close of entries.
- Riders who fail to register will not be included in moto draw.
- Random bike scrutineering will take place.

Disclaimer: Passing of a bicycle by a scrutineer does not warrant that it is deemed safe to ride.

<p>Riders Code of Conduct</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe the rules in the “UCI BMX Rule Book”. • Do not prevent other riders from riding to the best of their ability. • Never argue with an official. If you disagree consult the “Rider Advocate”. • Treat all other riders as you yourself would like to be treated. • Profanities, threats, physical violence or harassment in any form towards other riders or officials is unacceptable. • Do not bully, harass or take unfair advantage of other riders. • Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all riders and officials regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion. 	<p>Parents Code of Conduct</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage your children to participate, do not force them. • Focus on your child’s efforts and performance rather than winning or losing. • Appreciate good performance by all competitors and officials. • Respect officials’ decisions and teach your child to do likewise. • Never ridicule or yell at a rider for making a mistake or losing a race • Never badger, harass or use sarcasm to motivate your child. • Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every rider regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is needed. If your personal information is no longer needed for the purpose it was collected for, we will destroy it. If you believe that the privacy of your personal information has been compromised, you are entitled to complain to our privacy officer who will objectively and impartially assess your complaint.
